Additionally, the shopping centre is flanked by a library and health centre.

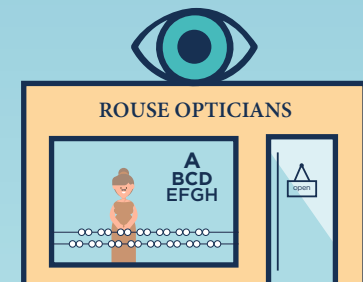

Location

Since 1973, North Point Shopping Centre has been at the heart of Bransholme, a suburb of Kingston upon Hull, which has earned a reputation as a thriving maritime city of culture with a population of more than one million people.

With four primary schools within a 10-minute walk and a further 10 schools within a 10-minute drive, North Point Shopping Centre is the perfect location for a leisure-based business to thrive.

Just under 1.5-mile away is Noddle Hill Way Nature Reserve – a remarkable, wildlife-packed beauty spot so secret only a select few knows it's there. Across its 118 acres, you'll find an idyllic fishing lake, some beautiful walks, playing fields, and a children's play area.

Bransholme's local community

The success of North Point Shopping Centre is fuelled by the passion and loyalty of its local residents.

Around 23,000 people reside within a 10-minute walk of the centre, while a secondary catchment of 77,000 live with a 10-minute drive.

Shoppers within these catchment areas alone are responsible for a collective annual spend of £208 million. And these figures are only set to increase with an expected resident population growth of 6.7% by 2025.

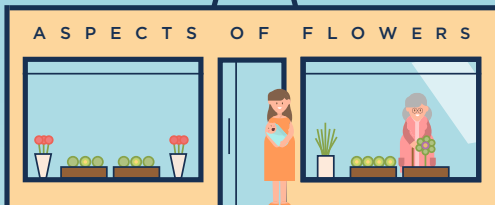


The site

Bransholme Market

North Point Shopping Centre's market hall offers an excellent opportunity for aspiring business owners to set up their stall with minimal start-up costs.

Covering 9,591 sq ft in total, the market hall has enough space to accommodate more than 40 individual stalls with many traders occupying multiple stalls to proudly showcase their offering.

Newly refurbished, the market hall now boasts new hardwearing flooring throughout with freshly laid vinyl for the stalls, as well as new standardised signage across all stalls, new roller shutters, new flagsigns pointing into alleyways, and a new LED neon sign for the market hall.

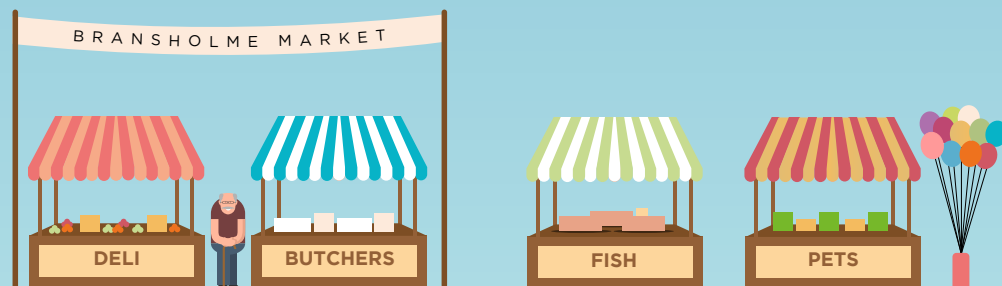
The refurb also introduced free Wi-Fi across the centre and resulted in the creation of a communal seating area with the surrounding perimeter stalls concentrating on a food focus.

Many long-standing dedicated stallholders have been here for more than 45 years but that doesn't mean there's no space newcomers. We help incoming traders get started by arranging for the installation of a flagsign and board around their stall.
