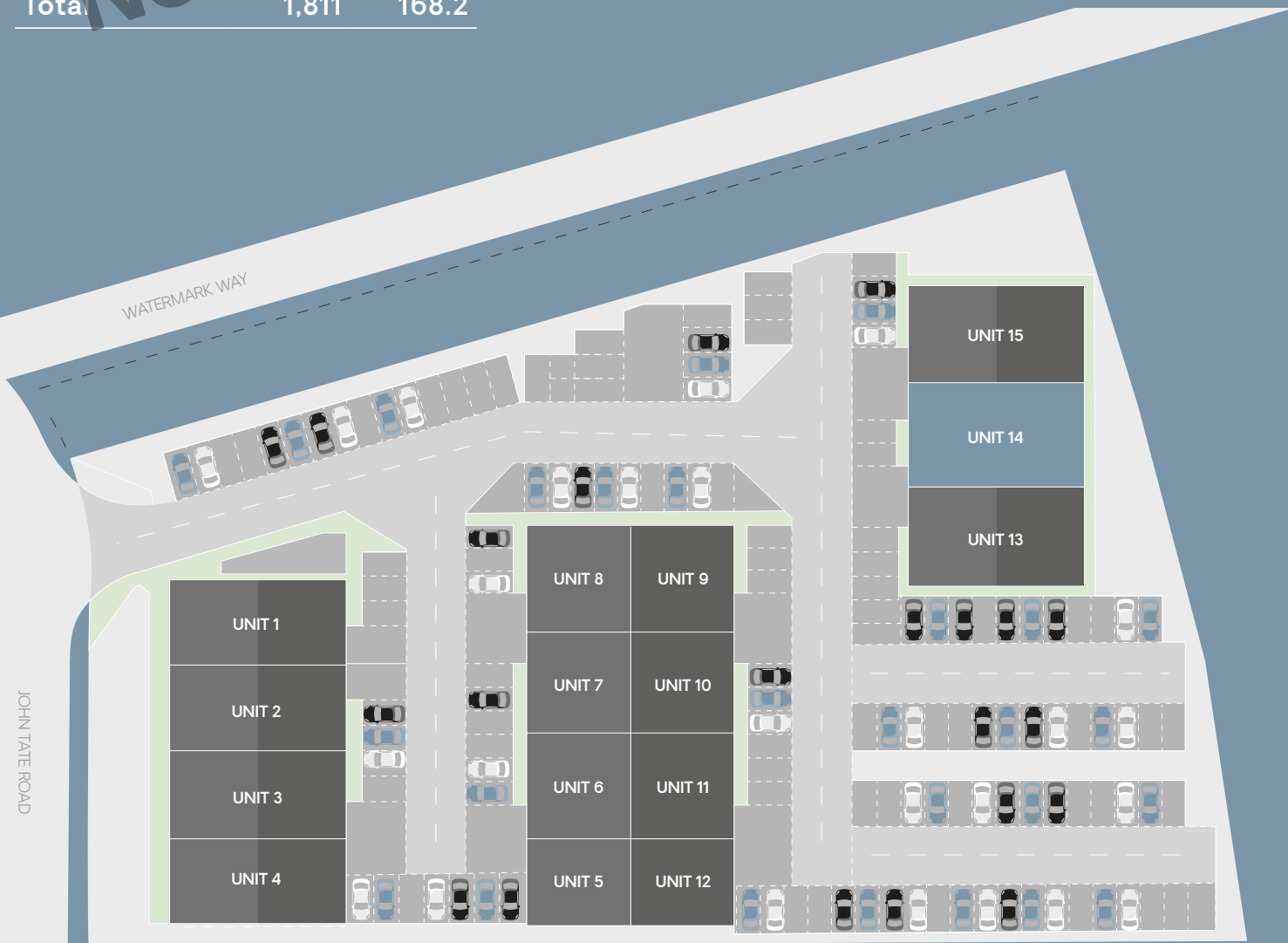

Location

Foxholes Business park is an established business location approximately 1 mile east of Hertford town centre. The park is situated adjacent to the A414 which links Hemel Hempstead to the west and Harlow to the east providing access to the M1, A1(M) and M11 motorways. The A10 is in close proximity providing good access to the M25 (Junction 25) 10 miles to the south.

Hertford East railway station provides a frequent service to London Liverpool Street with a journey time of circa 50 minutes.

Hertford North Station provides a fast service direct to Moorgate, with a journey time of 52 minutes.

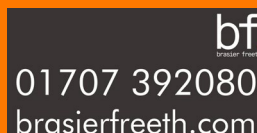
